Blood Donor Registry

Volunteer blood donor registry, sponsored by the Craven County Chapter of the American Red Cross with the cooperation of the Craven County Medical Society was established in the Havelock Project Community building May 22 from 1100 to 1400 for civilians living in the project and on the base.

This registry will provide for each citizen a readily available list of persons already typed who will be willing, when needed, to donate blood. It will eliminate costly delays in recovery from illness and the unnecessary expenses involved in a large group in order to find a donor of the proper blood type and with the proper RH blood factor. The registration file will be maintained in the office of the Craven County Chapter of the American Red Cross in New Bern.
