Area Rent Representative Comments on Expirations
 With most of the voluntary rent leases under the 1947 Act expiring the end of this month, area rent representative, A. U. Wilson of the New Bern Rent Control office, today explained what happens to dwelling units covered by such leases and what their maximum rent ceilings will be.
 "With the termination date of most of the leases under the 1947 Act only a few weeks off, this office has received many inquiries as to what will happen to units covered by these leases," Mr. Wilson said. "The holders of such leases want especially to know what the rent ceiling on such leases will be."
 "First as to what will happen to

units covered by such leases: Under the provisions of the Act, such units will automatically go back under rent control, with the tenant and the landlord having the same rights and protections as apply to controlled units that were not under lease.
 "As to the maximum rents for such units: The maximum rent will be the same as that provided in the expiring leases (provided the leases were valid)."
 Mr. Wilson also pointed out that

persons having leases under the 1947 Act, as well as those who have no leases, may execute leases under the 1948 Act.
 Leases must be voluntary on the part of both tenant and landlord, must be in writing, must run through Dec. 31, 1949, must be executed by Dec. 31, and filed with the area rent office within 15 days after execution.
