at the top of the machine and one at the end or side of the crateline contraption. "That propeller at the end," said Luther Paul, "would have permitted the machine to be so geared that it would travel forward or in reverse and the two propellers at the top have held the machine stationary in the air." "What do you think was the reason the machine did not actually fly?" I asked.

"The propellers. Made of canvas, they were not strong enough to carry the weight. I had been working on the idea of carving out a 3-blade propeller from Juniper, similar to a boat's propeller, when my wife persuaded me to give up the experiments."

the county contributes \$14,328 while the state contributes \$3,040. He called attention to the fact that the different state medical associations were promoting the Blue Cross health insurance plan for the low income group, which would cover all expenses associated with sickness, (medical, surgical and hospitalization) and that the physicians had agreed on a reduced fee schedule for the group which would bring this complete health insurance within the means of the low income group.

He decried federal "regimentation" of medicine, expressing the opinion that each state should work out its own program of medical care for the indigent and the low income group.
