Rules and Regulations Passed and Amended at The Meeting of the Board of Conservation & Development, Division of Commercial Fisheries at Salisbury, North Carolina, October 25-26, 1948. SHELLFISH RULES Rule No. 109 - Section II (Amend) Each packer, shucker, canner or other purchaser of resale of oysters shall first obtain a license for which he shall pay the sum of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) each, and shall cause to be delivered for planting on the oyster beds of the State at least one-half of the oyster shells so taken, delivery to be at the direction of the Commissioner of Fisheries or his agent.
