State Merchants Association Plans Large Program

RALEIGH - A 4-point program designed to strengthen and make more effective the operation of the North Carolina Merchants association among its 7,000 members has been announced by Thompson Greenwood, executive secretary of the organization which includes 60 merchants associations in all sections of the state.

Plans are being laid for special studies and surveys on store hours, distributive education, solicitations control, and the legislative needs of merchants, according to Greenwood.

"A new policy advisory committee composed of five local, merchants association secretaries will be named within a few days by Association President Jacob Winstead of Rocky Mount, and it is hoped that this committee will assist in the development of the program," said Greenwood.

He complimented highly another such group which worked closely with the state organization during February, March and April. Wesley Williams, secretary of the Raleigh Merchants bureau, was chairman of that committee, other members being Mrs. Cora Powell of Greenville; Charles C. Dudley, Charlotte; J. Ernest Yarbrough, Winston-Salem; and Mrs. Margaret Huggins, Hickory.

Greenwood said that, beginning in July, each member of the North Carolina Merchants association would receive a monthly bulletin in addition to "The Retailer," official publication of the organization. Special field men for Piedmont and western North Carolina will be employed in June.

State Ranks First In Crop Insurance

Another "first" for North Carolina was marked this week as Julian E. Mann, State director of the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation, announced that the Tar Heel State now leads the nation in number of farmers who have signed contracts for Federal insurance on their crops.

With only 17 counties participating, North Carolina has 30,560 crop insurance contracts in force. Of this number, 23,574 were signed in 1950, and the other 6,986 are carryovers from previous years. All contracts are written on a continuing basis and remain in effect until cancelled.

In addition, Mann said, the Tar Heel State has the highest percentage of eligible farmers signed up for insurance contracts in force. Cleveland leads all cotton counties in the state in percentage of farmers under contract. Beaufort, which started its program only this year, leads the tobacco counties, with Caswell and Jones tied for second place.

Mann said credit for the state's outstanding record in crop insurance is due to the work of county FIC committees and sales agents appointed by them, as well as to the cooperation of other agricultural agencies and farm groups.

Of North Carolina's total number of contracts, 23,670 are written on tobacco, 6,635 on cotton, and 246 on multiple crops. Tobacco insurance is offered in Caswell, Forsyth, Surry, Stokes, Vance, Wake, Beaufort, Duplin, Jones, Pitt, Wilson, and Columbus; cotton insurance, in Cleveland, Polk, Mecklenburg, and Rutherford; and multiple crop insurance, in Perquimans only.

Camp Lejeune Marine Fought Enemies at 14 CAMP LEJEUNE, N. C.—(AP)—When Marine Pfc. Lawrence R. Lamberti of New York City tells of fighting Nazis and Fascists at the ripe old age of 14, many of his Marine buddies are a little skeptical but his is no idle boast. Born and raised in Italy, Private Lamberti participated in many partisan sabotage activities including bridge blowing, sniping and small scale warfare, when the Germans occupied that country.

Even though he was a native Italian and didn't enter the United States until 1946, Lamberti is a fully naturalized citizen under United States law because his father came to this country in 1939 and became an American citizen before his son had reached his 18th birthday.

The Morehead City Technical Institute, he stated may never be able to supply the demand for graduates now facing it.

Director Rogests, who recently contacted 25 graduates of the institute, said that he found them working in power company plants, and phone companies, contractors, and in other occupations. One was serving as a member of the North Carolina highway patrol, and two were self employed.

The graduates, he continued, are employed as foremen, supervisors, operators, and production men.

Work Excellent "The boys," he commented, "are doing excellent work, and we are very pleased with their accomplishments. Their employers also seem pleased with their work."

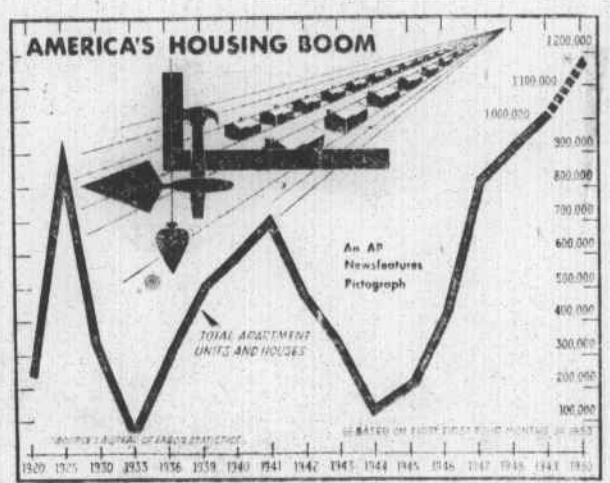
The institute, conducted under the auspices of the School of Engineering at State College, offers one-year technical courses in basic engineering theory and plant practices.
