The parties above named and all other persons will take notice that on the 29th day of November, 1950, the above named petitioner filed a petition in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Carteret County, to have the title to certain lands therein described registered and confirmed pursuant to the provisions of CHAPTER 43, GENERAL STATUTES OF NORTH CAROLINA 1943, as amended, and that summons has been issued returnable at the office of Clerk of Superior Court of Carteret County on February 5, 1951; said lands being situate in Morehead Township, on Bogue Banks, Carteret County, North Carolina and more particularly described as follows:

Lying on Bogue Banks: BEGINNING at the North edge of the State highway that runs from Atlantic Beach to Fort Macon, at a concrete monument in the line of the Fort Macon State Park land, running thence with said line North 1600 feet to a point opposite the mouth of Fishing Creek; then with the center of said creek and the State Park land eastwardly 2200 feet; then North 41-15 West 50 feet to an iron pipe, being the southwest corner of the tract of land torrenized by the Oaksmiths in 1919; thence with same as follows: North 41-15 West 1540 feet to an iron pipe; North 48-45 East 1000 feet to the low water mark of Fort Macon or Morehead Channel; thence with same North 45 West 2000 feet to the intersection of the low water mark of said channel and the low water mark of Bogue Sound or Tar Landing Bay; thence with the low water mark of Tar Landing Bay southwardly and westwardly to the west line of the Asbury Beach Subdivision extended north to Bogue Sound; thence with said extended line south 2000 feet to the north edge of the State Highway right-of-way; thence with said right-of-way eastwardly about 3600 feet to the beginning, containing 200 acres, more or less.
