Marine Corps Change Will Enable Behind-the-Lines Strikes by 'Copters

Washington — The Marine Corps has announced a reorganization plan under which its three combat divisions will be equipped to land behind enemy lines by helicopter. Gen. Randolph McF. Pate, commandant, said the shakedown will cover the Corps' three aircraft wings and supporting units. He said the change will begin April 1 and be completed by October. Basically, he said, the move will equip the corps to throw its troops into attack by helicopter and land deep behind enemy lines. In World War II and in Korea the Marines suffered heavy losses in landing by boat on strongly-defended beaches. Numbers Reduced The reorganization will reduce the numerical strength of each combat division from 21,000 officers and men to 19,000. Pate said they will have "complete air-transportability" and will be better able to disperse in an enemy atomic counter attack. Affected will be the 2nd Marine Division at Camp Lejeune, N. C., the 3rd Division stationed in Okinawa, the 2nd Marine Air Wing at Cherry Point, N. C., the 1st Marine Air Wing in Japan, and the 1st Brigade in Hawaii. Reorganization of the 1st Marine Division, now at Camp Pendleton, Calif., and the 3rd Marine Air Wing at El Toro, Calif., was completed last year. Pate said the two have tested the program and pronounced it a success. The overhaul will bring major changes in the corps' makeup, including: Each infantry battalion will have four rifle companies instead of three. Tanks will be assigned to troop units, instead of the entire division. A reconnaissance battalion will be added to each division. The air wings each will consist of 8,000 to 10,000 men with 400 attack bombers, fighters, transport planes and helicopters. Each also will have a helicopter reconnaissance squadron.

The Morehead City Jaycees have volunteered to help the town build a park at the section base, Camp Glenn. The town will level the park and plant grass and the Jaycees plan to help by putting in tables and benches. A discussion of plans for the new park was conducted at the Jaycee meeting Monday night at the Hotel Fort Macon. Jaycee president Dr. R. O. Barnum appointed three committees. Dr. Russell Outlaw was appointed chairman of a committee to study the proposed park. Bob McClain, Gerald Murdoch and Jerry Willis were appointed to examine the concession stand and ticket booth at the stock car track on Country Club Road to see if they could be moved to the football field. Finally, Dr. Barnum appointed a nominating committee to select candidates for office. A discussion of the district meeting to be held in Morehead City the last weekend in April concluded the meeting.
