Beach ABC Store Completes First Month's Operation

Sales at the county's newest ABC store, Atlantic Beach, amounted to \$7,730.55 last month. May was the first month the store was in operation.

Sales at the other stores in the county were as follows: Beaufort \$14,549.75, Morehead City \$24,660.85, and Newport \$9,558.95, making the total sales in the county last month \$56,500.10.

Paid to Beaufort was \$745.43, to Morehead City Hospital \$1,263.46, to Newport \$489.74 and to Atlantic Beach \$396.06. The county's share of proceeds was \$2,594.69.

Sales at the three established stores in May exceeded the sales in April.

Car Registration Rules Changed For Servicemen

Camp Lejeune - North Carolina has eased its automobile registration requirements for state-based servicemen, according to a bulletin received here by the legal offices from the State Motor Vehicle Department in Raleigh.

According to the bulletin, a car registration from a serviceman's last state of residence will now be honored in North Carolina until it expires, even though that state is not his "home" state. The new ruling specifically excludes legal residents of North Carolina.
