**John Bradshaw Leaves For Cruise to Europe**

Northern Europe—John W. Bradshaw, fireman, USN, son of Mr. and Mrs. W. G. Bradshaw of route 2 Newport, departed Norfolk, Va., June 10, aboard the destroyer USS Sigourney for a two-month Midshipman training cruise to Northern Europe.

During the voyage crew members will train Midshipmen in shipboard duties and responsibilities they will be expected to assume upon receiving their commissions. Between training exercises the Sigourney is scheduled to visit La-Coruna, Spain; Goteburg, Sweden; and Hamburg, Germany.
