Lieutenant Stallings is a graduate of the Woodrow Wilson High School in Portsmouth, Va., and Campbell College in Buies Creek. He is also a graduate of the Army Artillery Leadership School at Fort Chaffee, Ark., and the Infantry Officers School at Fort Benning, Ga. He served on active duty from January 1945 until August 1947, during which time he saw a tour of duty in Japan. He has been a member of the Army Reserves since September 1947. He was commissioned a second lieutenant in October 1952 and promoted to first lieutenant in October 1953.
