ORDER AUTHORIZING \$2,500,000 SCHOOL BUILDING BONDS WHEREAS, The Carteret County Board of Education has certified to this Board a resolution passed on December 1, 1958, showing that adequate school facilities are not now available in the County of Carteret to comply with the requirements of Section 3 of Article IX of the Constitution of North Carolina for the maintenance of schools six months in every year, and that it is necessary, in order to maintain such six months' school term as required by said Section 3 of Article IX of the Constitution, to erect additional school buildings and other school plant facilities, remodel, enlarge and reconstruct existing school buildings and other school plant facilities, and acquire necessary land and equipment therefor, to provide additional school facilities in the County of Carteret, the estimated cost of which is \$2,500,000; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has carefully examined the facts and has determined and does hereby find as a fact that said statements of the above mentioned resolution are true and that it has become the duty of said Board of Commissioners, acting as an administrative agent of the State in providing a State system of public schools, to order the issuance of bonds of the County of Carteret so that the school facilities mentioned in paragraph 1 of this order and in said resolution may be provided in order to maintain the six months' school term in the County of Carteret as required by Section 3 of Article IX of the Constitution; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED
