Veteran's Preference Still Observed

Immediately after World War I, World War II, and the Korean Conflict most veterans knew about benefits and services available to them through the Serviceman's Readjustment Act. What many veterans do not realize is that a continuing program of service is still available to them now. Veteran's preference is still observed in job referrals, employment counseling and in referrals to training.

Training is now available under the Manpower Training Act at no cost to the trainee. Most veterans are eligible for training allowances, dependents allowances, and subsistence allowances. Allowances range from \$35 weekly to \$75 weekly. Training has been given recently in auto mechanics, machinist, electrician, construction-equipment mechanic, carpentry, bricklaying, welding, drafting, chemist assistant and other occupations.

The goal of the Manpower Training Act is to provide occupational training for unemployed persons, to equip them with skills so that they may secure and maintain suitable full-time employment.

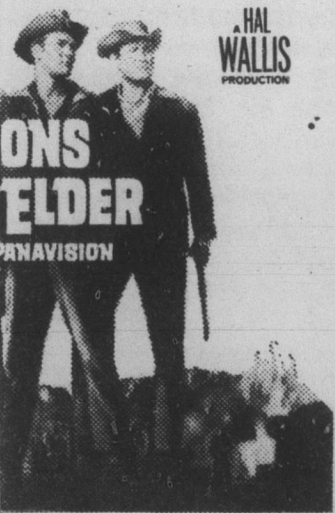

GIFTS

John Jones owns a United States savings bond issued in his name as sole owner. How may he transfer ownership to another as a gift?

This may be done only by having the bond reissued in the name of the donee in accordance with regulations of the government.

He may, of course, redeem or "cash" the bond and then deliver the proceeds to the donee.

The law makes an exception if the donor makes a physical delivery to the donee at a time when he is in contemplation of death from a present illness or some immediate peril. This is what lawyers call a gift "causa mortis" (on account of death).

Government savings bonds cannot be voluntarily sold or used as collateral or security for the performance of an obligation.

May a person transfer ownership of property to another reserving to himself a life estate?

Yes. This may be done by writing in respect to either real or personal property.

This may also be accomplished by a donor setting up a trust during his lifetime. For example, a donor may transfer either real or personal property to a trustee for the use of the donor himself for life and upon his death the property passing to another.

Are there any restrictions upon a wife conveying her property to her husband?

Yes. A wife in North Carolina cannot directly or indirectly convey real property which she owns to her husband without being examined separate and apart from her husband by a designated certifying official, who incorporates in his certificate his conclusions and findings of fact that the conveyance is not unreasonable or injurious to her.

The particular statute was passed to protect the wife from the influence and control which the husband is presumed to have over her by reason of the marital relation.

The statute is not applicable to transfers of personal property between the spouses nor to conveyances of real property from the husband to his wife.
