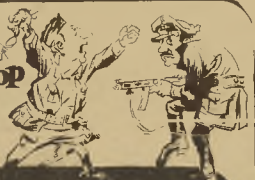

## OUR HEALTH

### Smart Gargling

Proper oral hygiene has occu-  
pied man's attention for thou-  
sands of years. Assyrians, about  
1300 B.C., invented toothpicks,  
and the Chi-  
nese gave us  
the toothbrush  
almost 500  
years ago.

Mouth-  
washes, too,  
have long been  
part of daily  
oral care. Of course, antiseptic  
or germicidal mouthwash is rec-  
ent; before that man gargled  
with—and sometimes swallowed—  
everything from brandy, port  
wine with alum, to salt water  
and lemon water.

There are many misconcep-  
tions about mouthwashes — what  
they do and don't do. Mouthwash-  
es or gargles can neither prevent  
nor cure a cold and they cannot  
eradicate bad breath, although  
they may mask it for a while.

Then, you ask, what good are  
they? Mouthwashes do serve a  
very useful purpose. Used after  
meals, a mouthwash cleanses the  
mouth and teeth of many food  
particles. When gargled, Chlora-
