Kaufman comedy, will open the 1967-68 season for the University of North Carolina at Greensboro, when the UNC-G Theatre presents their production Nov. 8-12. 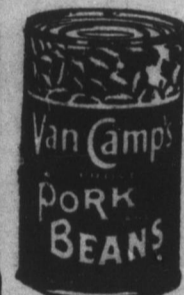
