

## Camp Easter To Begin

Mr. Roger McKinney, Yancey County Easter Seal Board Member, announces that Camp Easter-in-the-Pines is now accepting camper applications. In 1970 Camp Easter provided camping experiences to over 260 individuals throughout the state. The 70-acre campsite, located in Southern Pines, serves handicapped persons in wheelchairs, with braces and crutches and various other physical disabilities and limitations.

A new addition to the specially designed facilities is a 75-foot-long swimming pool with ramps, handrails and other features to accommodate even the most severely involved campers. The activities at Camp are planned adapted to meet the needs of the handicapped and goals of the program include social as well as physical growth.

Camp staff of young men and women, mostly from health related field of study in colleges and universities, serve the 64 who can be enrolled each session.

The Blue Ridge Easter Seal Society, the 20-county Western North Carolina region to which Yancey County belongs, sent 10 campers last year and hopes to send more in 1971, explained Mr. McKinney. The 1971 Camping Season has 5 sessions: June 13-25, ages 9-12; June 25-July 9, ages 18 up; July 11-23, ages 6-10; July 25 - August 6, ages 11-14; August 8-20, ages 13-18. Take notice that a pleading seeking relief against you has been filed in the above entitled special proceeding. The nature of the relief sought is as follows:

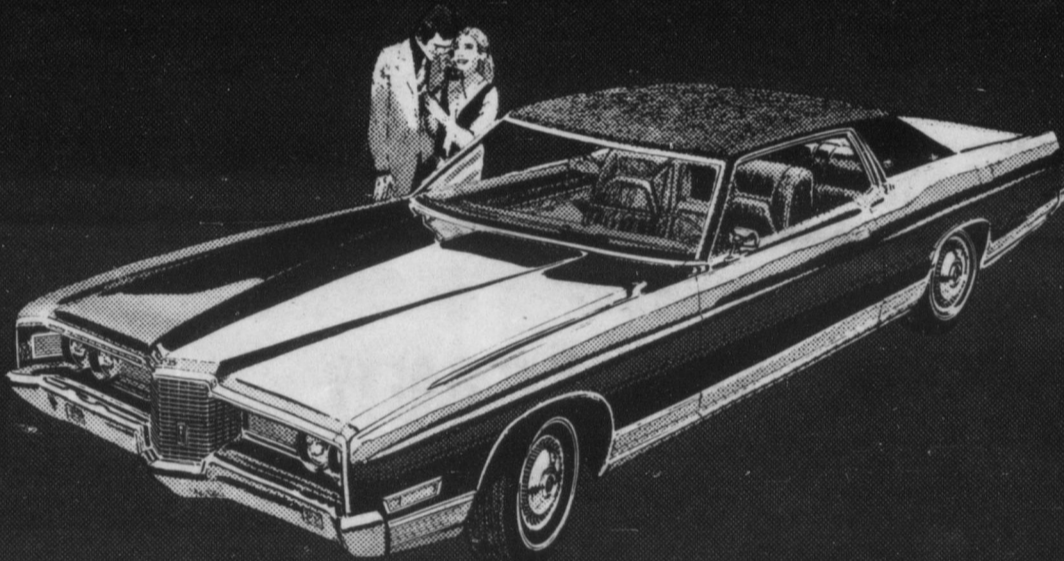
