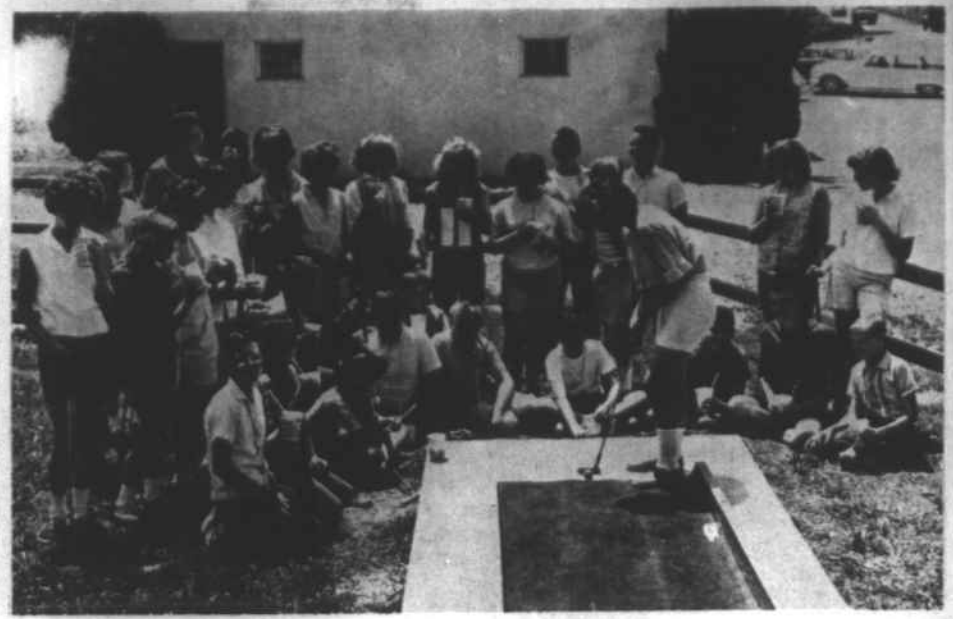
Nantahala P & L To Close On Saturdays

FRANKLIN - Nantahala Power and Light Company's retail offices in Andrews, Bryson City, Franklin, Robbinsville and Sylva will be closed Saturdays, effective June 1, company officials announced this week.

In the past, the retail offices have been open until noon on Saturdays. The power company's retail offices will continue to be open from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday for payment of bills and customer service.

Nantahala's President, John M. Archer, Jr., explained that the decision to close the company's five retail offices on Saturdays was part of an overall effort to slow the rising costs faced by the company.
