Postmaster Says Air Mail Solution

Air Mail Solution

The use of air mail for letters which should not be delayed in transit is being recommended by Postmaster O. L. Hoffman of the Mount Holly Post Office. Due to the strike which has paralyzed railway service and much of the mail transportation system, air mail has become the idea solution for letters which must reach their destinations on schedule, Mr. Hoffman pointed out and stated that many business and industries in this section have already posted large numbers of air mail letters taking advantage of the speedy service offered.

In most cases where letters are posted to addresses outside the state, Mr. Hoffman said, air mail will get them to the destinations on time when they might otherwise be delayed for some time until the Post Office Department has made arrangements with trucks for the transfer of mail. Anyone who wishes information concerning air mail schedules can obtain it from any of the clerks in the local post office.
