## RAILROAD HEAVILY ASSESSED

New Haven, Conn. — In a suit

against the New Haven Railroad for a broken neck received in an accident 23 years ago, Jean Annett, of Red Bank, N. J., was awarded \$161,577 damages, sufficient to pay an annuity of \$8,400 a year for the 20 years she expects to live. At the time of the accident, she was given only a few months to live, and the railroad contracted to pay her \$10,000 in cash and \$700 a month for life. Miss Annett continued to live, although a helpless invalid. The railroad considered it had discharged its original obligation and the suit followed.
