Tiered candelabra accented with greenery decorated the church.

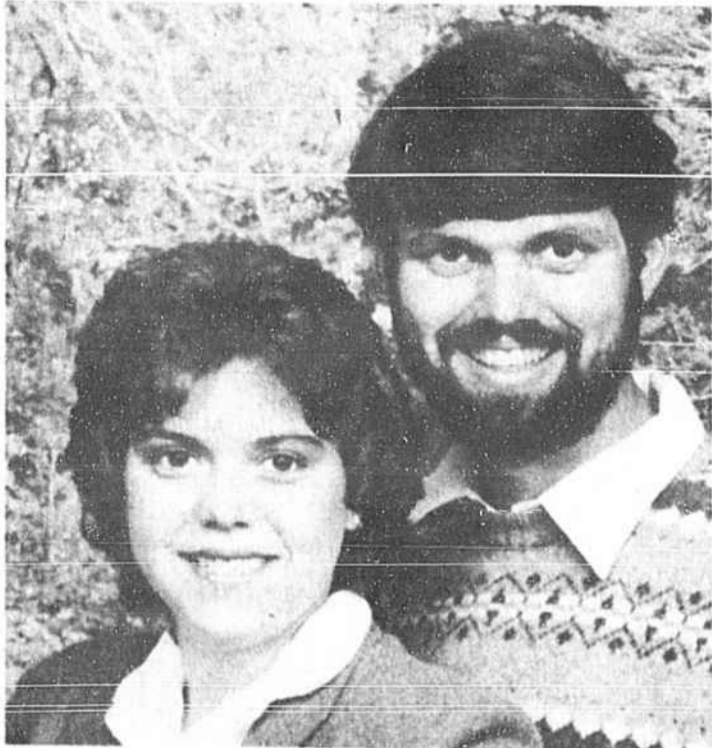
