# BTC Is Beating Enrollment Odds

While most sister institutions are experiencing dramatic drops in enrollment, Brunswick Technical College continues to grow. Over 250 students are enrolled for credit courses. Approximately 2500 students are enrolled throughout the county in continuing education courses during the summer quarter. "Summer is traditionally the time when fewer students are on campus, but we are very pleased our enrollment has far exceeded any previous summer enrollment," said Connie Powell, college public information of-

ficer.

Though enrollment at BTC has consistently increased, it is not without hard work on the part of college employees, administrators, faculty members and students, said Powell.

"When a person expresses an interest in enrolling in a course, his or her name immediately goes into our information system. That system guarantees that he or she will be contacted by mail, telephone, or a visit from a college representative. Every college employee is involved in promoting Brunswick Tech," said Poweil. Enrollment for the fall quarter is expected to surpass all enrollment records for the young college. two years of credit toward a four-year degree is also growing rapidly. "The news that students can live at home and pay only \$51 in tuition per quarter is spreading," said Powell. General education is one of the fastest growing programs at the col-lege.

Economically disadvantaged adults will have an opportunity to hone job-seeking skills in a "How To Get A Job" course offered by Brunswick Technical College, beginning Aug. 5.

There will be no charge for registration or books and qualified students will receive a travel stipend of up to \$15.00 per week. The course will consist of 6-8 weeks of basic orientation and motivation, basic education, and skills enhancement.

The human resources development program is designed to give adults the job-seeking edge by teaching them to sell themselves to prospective employers by strengthening their basic educational knowledge or completing their high school equivalency, where necessary.

HRD is mainly a jobs program. It will help job seekers overcome the unemployment "terrors" according to college HRD Coordinator, Linda Ready.
