

## Girl Scout Registration Underway



Girls interested in exploring new opportunities can participate in Girl Scout registration now underway.

Special registration nights scheduled around the county will give girls an opportunity to find out more about Girl Scouting in general as well as what troops are located in their neighborhoods.

Girl Scouting's program is designed to help girls grow self-awareness and skills, to contribute to their communities and to be good citizens, said Connie Schutte, a spokesman for the Brunswick County Girl Scout Council.

Girls explore different opportunities through the five "Worlds of Girl Scouting:" art, people, well-being, out-of-doors, and today and tomorrow.

Girl Scout troops exist in all parts of the county for girls in first through ninth grades and if interest warrants, a troop for senior high girls would be

started, Mrs. Schutte said.

The first special registration night will be held Tuesday, Sept. 10, from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. at the Town Creek Township Park Building for girls in the Leland, Winnabow, Boiling Springs Lakes and Bolivia areas.

Two sessions are scheduled on Wednesday, Sept. 11. Girls in the Calabash, Holden Beach, Ocean Isle, Sunset Beach and Shallotte areas are invited to registration at Jennies Branch Baptist Church on N.C. 179 from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.

In the Southport-Oak Island area, girls will gather at Sportsworld for registration and skating from 7:30 p.m. to 9 p.m.

On Friday, Sept. 13, girls in the Ash area can attend registration night at the Waccamaw Township Park Building near the elementary school from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Also, Mrs. Schutte said, Girl Scouts isn't just limited to girls. Adult volunteers are needed as leaders and assistant leaders for troops of all ages. Volunteers can also sign up during registration week. Those who are interested in being an adult volunteer or registering someone as a Girl Scout and cannot attend a registration night are asked to call either Martha Bridges, 253-5386, or Peggy Heron, 287-6894.

The registration nights replace the in-school surveys through which girls have signed up for Scouting in past years.
