BTC Hopes To Cure Illiteracy With Computers

Brunswick Technical College will begin a new learning concept in its on-going battle against illiteracy beginning early next year. Called PLATO—Programmed Logic for Automatic Teaching Operations—the computer-based curriculum is designed to help adults acquire reading, writing, and math skills usually learned in grades three through eight. Research has indicated students may advance as much as one grade level after only 20 hours of PLATO basic skills instruction. Experts define functional illiterate as someone who cannot read or write or compute math well enough to cope with society. Nearly 5000 adults in Brunswick County cannot read or write, according to Willie Fullwood, Brunswick Tech adult basic education director. "We hope to reduce this number considerably with the use of PLATO and other basic adult education courses offered free of charge to adults 18 years of age or older," he said. "With the use of PLATO, students see positive results in a shorter period of time. They begin to see how it affects them in their jobs and in their lives," said Fullwood. Students are praised for correct answers. They are instructed on how to repeat an exercise when answers are incorrect. Instruction begins with simple tasks related to the student's level of competence, and basic skills must be mastered before more complex tasks are introduced. Funding by the 1985 General Assembly provided the PLATO computers to all 58 institutions in the North Carolina Department of Community Colleges. Brunswick Tech will utilize ten of the units in its Adult Basic Education Program. The PLATO project has two principal goals. The first is to help undereducated adults become better functioning citizens by providing survival skills in basic reading, math, and English. The second goal, aimed for by most of the program's participants, is preparation for the high school equivalency (GED).

CT Scans Available At Supply Hospital

As of Oct. 1, a new radiological diagnostic procedure, CAT scanning, is available at Brunswick Hospital at Supply. A mobile unit visits the hospital each Monday and Thursday morning to provide the diagnostic imaging, which allows doctors to look inside the human body without performing surgery. The mobile service is self-contained in a large semi-trailer and is operated by a staff of three individuals who work closely with the host radiological department. Supply is the only location in the county where the service is available.
