# Social Services Board Quickly Finishes Work

Brunswick County Board of Social Services members dispatched a routine workload quickly Monday night, meeting for 1½ hours at the social services department.

The board voted to begin advertising to fill a new, part-time temporary social worker position in the child protective services section. A state grant will finance the position for about 18 months, said Director Jamie Orrock.

Members also learned that another surplus federal food commodities would be distributed once more before the Christmas holidays, on Dec. 13 and 14, following the same procedures used in the past.

Social Worker Supervisor Evelyn Johnson said that a letter has been sent to chore service recipients telling them any contributions they can make will be used to further the program, as required by federal guidelines. And, as recommended in the agency's audit, the self-addressed envelopes used to mail in the contributions will be sent directly to the county finance office, not to the

social services department.

The board delayed a scheduled evaluation of Director Jamie Orrock in executive session in order to allow more time for observation and evaluation, "to be fair to the board and to Mr. Orrock," said Chairman Frankie Rabon.

Board members and Orrock agree that regular evaluations of all employees, including the department head, are good and are needed. In fact, Orrock had asked the board to evaluate his performance.

"I feel all employees need to be evaluated," agreed Chairman Frankie Rabon.

## Two Riegelwood Residents Killed In One-Car Wreck

Two Riegelwood residents were killed Sunday at 7:40 p.m. in an accident approximately a mile from Navassa on S.R. 1423 (Vernon Road), according to Ruby Oakley, N.C. Highway Patrol spokesman.

Dana Lee Freeman, 24, and Felicia Freeman, 25, died in the one-car wreck, bringing the loss of lives Brunswick County roads to 14 this year, up from 11 this time last year.

Dana Lee Freeman was driving a 1983 Mazda east on Vernon Road when he ran off on the left shoulder on a left hand curve and lost control of the car. The vehicle continued off the left shoulder until it struck the ditch bank, continuing in the ditch for 100 feet. The car came back on the road and overturned, throwing the passengers from the car, then came to rest right side up.

Trooper D.A. Lewis investigated

the accident.

The car received \$6,000 in damages.
