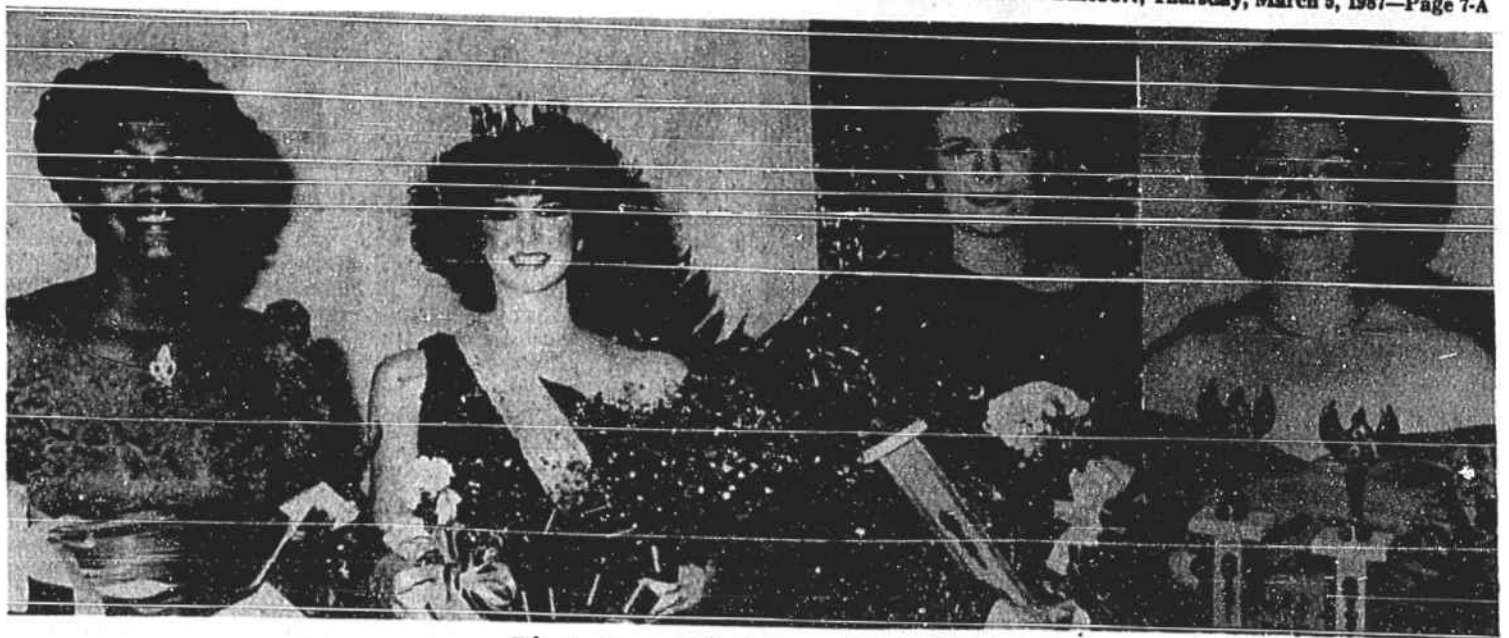

## FEMA Official To Discuss Flood Insurance At Calabash

Carol Campbell of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) regional office in Atlanta will meet at 3:30 p.m. Thursday, March 12, at the Calabash Town Hall with town officials and concerned citizens regarding the National Flood Insurance Program.

Calabash officials voted nearly a year ago to participate in the federal insurance program, but have not adopted a flood damage prevention ordinance pending receipt of flood elevation data, said Town Clerk Janet Thomas.

water would rise along the Calabash River is 13 feet. Other areas where waters would rise significantly are along sloughs, said Thomas.

The town is mapped in an "A" zone, she said. Only fill dirt, not pilings, will be required to bring properties to the minimum elevations set by

the program to reduce the likelihood of flood damage.

Some restaurant owners had been concerned that if they rebuilt, their businesses would have to be set on pilings, she said.

The meeting with FEMA officials had been rescheduled from earlier this year.
