The meeting is open to any class member interested in helping with the arrangements, said Kelly Winfree.



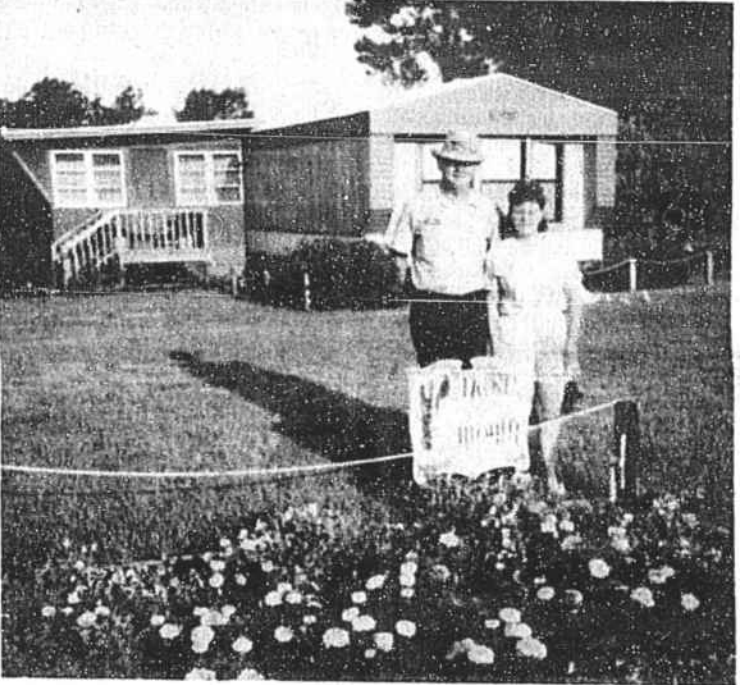
## To Wed June 20

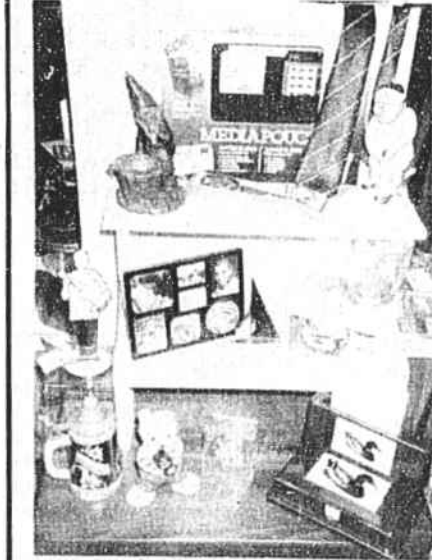
