The Brunswick County Planning Board will be guests of Carteret County Thursday and Friday, July 23-24, while a Coastal Resources Commission meeting is held there.

Planning Director John Harvey said the board, along with Pender County officials, will receive a tour of Carteret County, sponsored by its economic development office. The board will also attend a program on aquaculture sponsored by the Duke Marine Laboratory.

Ed Gore, planning board chairman, and Alan Holden said they also plan to attend sessions of the CRC meeting while in Morehead City.

The planning board held its monthly meeting last Wednesday, July 15, and gave preliminary approval to the following plat proposals:

•An unnamed subdivision containing ten lots south of Pigott Road at Shallotte Point, filed by Pete Inman Jr.

•Camelot Acres on N.C. 87 between Mill Creek Road and Danford Road, containing 22 lots in Phase I and 20 lots in Phase II, filed by Arthur B. Davis;

•Section II, The Village of Four Seasons subdivision on Big Neck Road near Waccamaw, containing 49 lots, filed by Patrick H. Simmons;

•An unnamed subdivision north of the Shallotte North Subdivision on U.S. 17, containing 29 lots, filed by Jesse O. Simmons; and

•Flowering Dogwood Place, north of N.C. 130 (Holden Beach Road) and adjacent to High Hill Drive, containing 23 lots, filed by Jerry McLamb.
