Brunswick Man Sentenced For Tax Evasion

A Leland area man received a suspended sentence last week in Brunswick County Criminal District Court after pleading no contest to state income tax evasion charges in May.

According to the Brunswick County Clerk of Court office, Judge David G. Wall on Sept. 28 sentenced Oscar Robertus Long III, 40, of Route 3, Leland, to a six-month prison, suspended for three years, with three years of supervised probation.

Also, Wall ordered Long to pay a \$600 fine and court costs, as well as the \$7,723.95 in taxes, penalties and interest he owed.

Long was arrested March 17 in connection with two counts of attempting to evade taxes, involving his 1984 and 1985 state income tax returns. He was released on a \$500 secured bond.

On May 13, Long pleaded no contest to the tax evasion charges; sentencing was continued until last week's court term.






