An Ash man escaped serious injury Friday night when the auto in which he was a passenger struck a house near Ash, according to N.C. Highway

Patrol spokesperson Ruby Oakley. The accident occurred Friday at 10:30 p.m. on S.R. 1332 (Stout Road), 9.1 miles west of Shallotte.

Ms. Oakley said a 1979 Ford, registered to Ellis Cleatus Gore, was traveling north when it ran through a stop sign at the intersection of Stout Road and Mill Branch Road.


