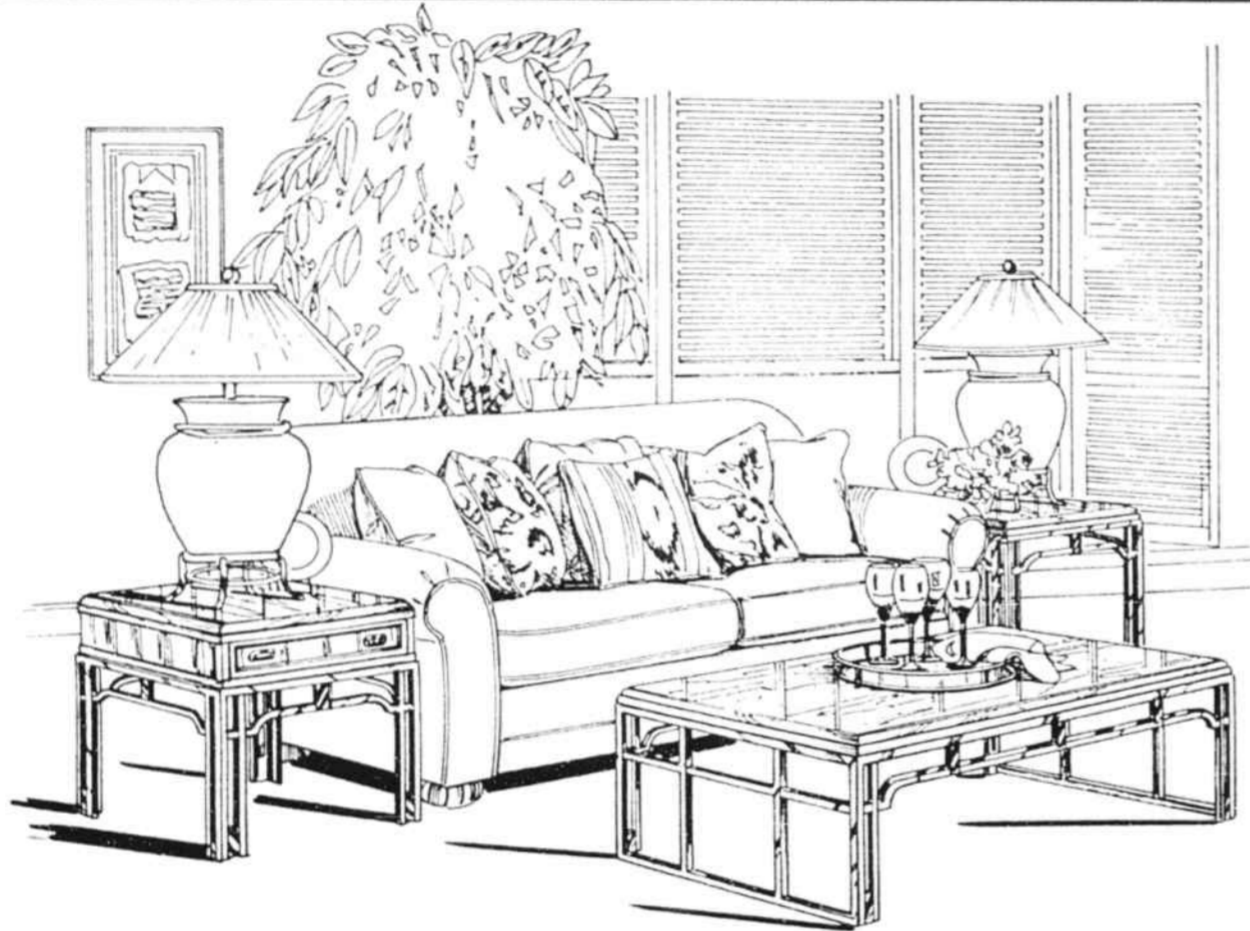


A FORMAL DINING AREA and a casual "breakfast bar" overlook the waterway.
