Class Targets Young Parents

A free class on effective parenting will be offered this summer at Brunswick Community College for parents or soon-to-be parents ages 14 through 21.

Sponsored through the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) program, the skills class will begin Monday, July 12, and continue through Thursday, Aug. 5. Classes will meet Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The class will cover a variety of skills needed by parents, such as time management, goal setting and basic first aid. Guest speakers will share information about educational opportunities, wellness and public assistance programs.

In addition to there being no charge for tuition, books, supplies and insurance, JTPA funds will pay up to \$35 a week for child care expenses. Participants may also be eligible to receive transportation assistance.
