Student Who Took Gun To School Sentenced To Write Paper

student who admitted bringing a gun, a blackjack and two knives to school was ordered to "conduct himself as a gentleman" and write a 10page paper on youth violence after pleading guilty in district court last

Corey Jermaine Robbins, 17, of Old Fayetteville Road, Leland, pleaded guilty to a charge of possessing a weapon on school property after being arrested Sept. 16.

Robbins was accused of being on the grounds of North Brunswick High School while in possession of a .25-caliber revolver, a "dirk dagger," a blackjack and a long-blade pocket knife, according to the arrest

District Court Judge Ola Lewis agreed to postpone sentencing of Robbins until April 11, 1994, on the condition that he perform 30 hours of community service, maintain a "C" average in school and obey an 8 p.m. curfew seven nights a week. He was told "to conduct himself as a gentleman" at school and to not misbehave or be tardy.

In addition, the judge ordered Robbins to write a 10-page typed paper on "what he intends to do with his future and what effect a criminal record may have." The paper is to include "information on youth violence in America."

Judge Lewis presided over three days of district court in Bolivia last week. Assistant district attorneys Don Kelly, Rick Green and Lillian Salcines prosecuted cases for the state. Marie Jordan served as courtroom clerk.
