Supply Man Gets Suspended Sentence In Three Break-Ins

given an eight-year suspended prison sentence and ordered to pay back more than \$2,000 in restitution after pleading guilty in Brunswick County District Court last week to three charges of breaking and entering and one charge of larceny.

The defendant, Tony Lee Johnson of Route 2, admitted breaking into two homes on Little Macedonia Road and a truck owned by an appliance company last April and May.

Under the terms of his suspended sentence, Johnson was put on intensive probation and ordered to observe a 9 p.m. curfew, seven nights a week, for two years. He was also told to obtain a substance abuse assessment within 30 days and to follow any recommended treatment.

Judge Napoleon Barefoot presided over three days of district court last week, with Assistant District Attorney Rick Green prosecuting and Marie Jordan serving as courtroom clerk.
