The 'Cats generated 247 yards of offense against the Trojans, but they committed four turnovers that led to 14 West Brunswick points. For the first time this season, the Trojans did not commit any turnovers.

Coach Brett said he was surprised by the easy win, especially since it followed a bad week of practice.

"It was the worst week of practice we've had since I've been here," the second-year head coach said. "We had one starter quit and a couple kids get injured. I guess we don't need to worry about it now.'

West Brunswick, which rushed for 282 yards per game during the regular season, has averaged 440 yards in the first two playoff games.

"I think we finally started concentrating and doing what we do best." said offensive tackle Steve Brooks. "We had it inside and now we're showing what we can do.

"This is our third time here in the playoffs," Brooks added. "We know what to expect and we know we have to play hard if we want to get back to that number one spot."

The Trojans, winners of last year's state 2A football championship, have won 11 out of 12 playoff games over the last three years. West is the state's only team to play in a state championship game each of the last two years.

West Brunswick (9-3) will host Reidsville (12-0) in the third round of the state 3A playoffs Friday night. Eastern Randolph finished the season with a 9-3 record.




