

Fishing Seminar Set At Springmaid Beach

The peak fishing season may have come and gone, but that doesn't mean there aren't saltwater fish such as speckled trout that can be caught all winter long.

Fishing columnist Jim Godfrey of Myrtle Beach, S.C., will address winter fishing during a seminar Saturday, Dec. 11, at Springmaid Beach Resort. Hours are 10 a.m. until 4 p.m.

Godfrey will be assisted by several professionals during the program, which is presented by Just Angling Seminars of South Carolina.

Offshore map-maker Chip Berry

will discuss how to find offshore gamefish year round. He will talk about finding and catching billfish, tuna, wahoo and dolphin.

"For those with the drive and the boats to go with it, kings on top and grouper on bottom can be caught all winter," Berry said.

He will emphasize spring, summer and fall fishing. Berry will discuss how to find hard bottom, reefs and wrecks, as well as bait rigging and trolling techniques.

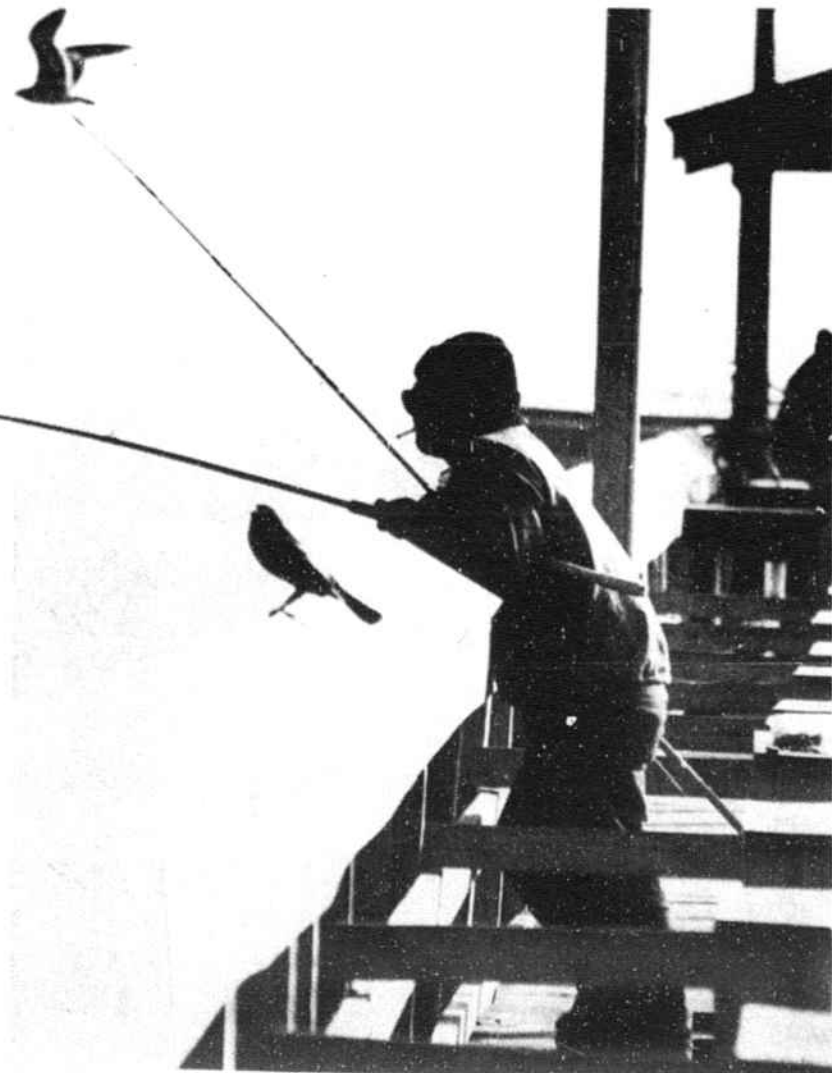
Donald Millus of Coastal Carolina University, who has written two books and numerous articles on salt-

water fishing, will present a slide survey of fishing in the Carolinas.

"This program is for the experienced angler who wants to perfect his or her techniques as well as for

the novice who wants to learn about saltwater fishing," Millus said.

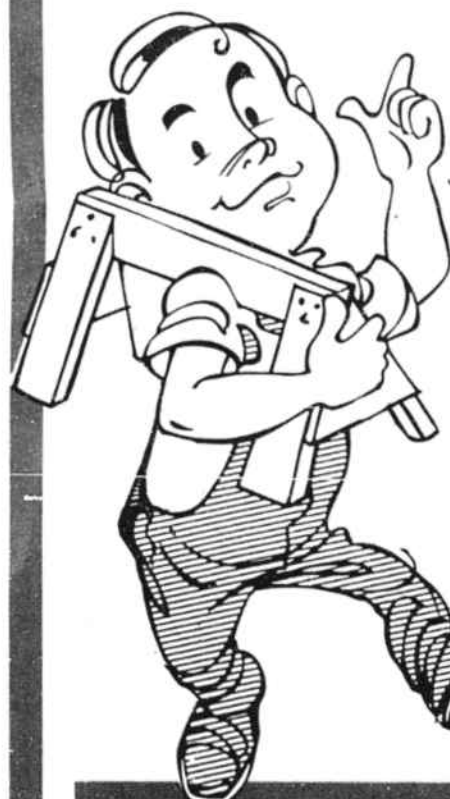
