'Aladdin' On Bill At Thalian Hall

Tickets for the 1994 North Carolina Jazz Festival are sold out, but fans can still enjoy the classic swing and Dixieland jazz showcased in the festival by attending the N.C. Jazz Festival preview at Thalian Hall on Thursday, Feb. 3, at 8 p.m.

The preview offers two one-hour sets, featuring some of the festival's finest musicians. Leading the preview will be a quartet of musicians who have performed at the festival for more than ten years.

Kenny Davern, clarinet; Bob Rossengarden, drums; and Milton Hinton, bass, will be joined by pianist John Sheridan for a set of improvised classic jazz.

The second set will be performed by the Jim Cullum Jazz Band of San Antonio, Texas. The band has been seen on PBS and on stage at Carnegie Hall and Kennedy Center. Their program, "Riverwalk, Live from the Landing," is distributed nationally by American Public Radio.

Tickets for the festival preview are \$14, \$12 and \$10, with discounts available for groups or Thalian Hall members. The event is presented by the N.C. Jazz Festival and Thalian Hall Center for the Performing Arts, Inc.
