

South Brunswick High wrapped up a share of its third straight Waccamaw Conference girls' basketball championship Friday night with a 49-25 win over host West Brunswick.

The Lady Cougars finished the regular season 9-3 in the conference and tied for first place with Whiteville, which beat East Columbus 59-48 on Friday to carn a piece of the league title.

The conference title came as somewhat of a surprise to South Brunswick Coach Mike Isenberg, who was unsure of his team at the start of the season with just two experienced players back from last year's 26-1 squad.

"Needless to say I'm tickled to death with what we've done after losing our whole lineup last year," Isenberg said following Friday night's win.

South, which has won two straight conference tournaments, entered this week's tourney with an overall record of 15-8. The Lady Cougars will receive the Waccamaw's number one 3A seed in the upcoming state playoffs.

Last Friday's win at West Brunswick avenged a 69-67 triple overtime loss to the Lady Trojans earlier this season in Boiling Spring Lakes.

The Lady Cougars held a 12-point halftime lead in that game on Jan. 29, and led by the same margin last Friday at West.


