Summer Science Day Camp To Be Sponsored By UNC-W

Adventures in learning and coastal and environmental awareness are the goal of Summer Science-by-the-Sea Day Camp, sponsored by the UNC-Wilmington Division for Public Service and Extended Education.

The camp for 7-to-11-year-olds is co-sponsored with the N.C. Aquarium at Fort Fisher and the New Hanover County public schools.

Activities include animal and plant studies, outdoor exploration, natural crafts and hands-on experience in environmental awareness activities.

Sessions began on Monday, end on Friday afternoon and are held rain or shine. Round-trip bus trans-

portation is provided from UNCW's Kenan Auditorium parking lot to the N.C. Aquarium at Fort Fisher. Each day begins at 8 a.m. and ends at 4:30 p.m.

Cost is \$80 per student per week. For registrations received by May 13, the fee will be discounted to \$70 per week. Fee includes round-trip transportation from UNCW to the N.C. Aquarium, all supplies, activities, field trips and a T-shirt.

Camp sessions are June 13-17, June 20-17, June 27-July 1, July 5-8, July 11-15, July 18-22, July 25-29, Aug. 1-5 and Aug. 8-12.
