You will also have to pay interest on any taxes due from April 15 until the date your payment is received by the IRS. Be aware that special rules apply to people in the Armed Forces.

Payment Extensions

What if you simply cannot pay your tax liability at the time you file for an extension? In such cases, you must submit Form 1127. This form requires you to document the details of any extraordinary hardship preventing you from paying your taxes on time. The IRS will review your case to determine if a late payment is acceptable. There are also procedures for requesting an installment payment agreement when you file your return.




The first payment is due April 15 (or for fiscal-year taxpayers, the initial due date of their income tax returns), with the second and third installments due on April 15 of each succeeding year. This will apply even if you end up getting a refund on your 1993 tax return.

No interest or underpayment of estimated tax penalty will be charged if you pay the taxes attributable to the retroactive rate increase on this installment basis.

About Your Refund...

If you are expecting a tax refund, keep in mind that the IRS has 45 days from the later of the original due date of your tax return or the date you actually file the return to issue you a refund and does not need to pay you any interest on the refund amount. Different rules apply to amended returns.




