

Man Gets Two Years In Prison For Not Delivering Rock

A 45-year-old Leland man was sentenced to two years in prison last week after admitting in Brunswick County District Court that he took \$20 from another Leland man in exchange for a truck load of rock that was never delivered.

Robert Albert Edwards of Route 3 had been charged with the felony of obtaining property by false pretense. In a plea bargaining arrangement, he agreed to plead guilty to a misdemeanor larceny charge, court records show.

Edwards was ordered to serve a two-year prison term to run concurrently with any sentence he is now serving.

Judge Ola Lewis presided over three days of district court in Bolivia last week. Assistant District Attorney Lillian Salcines prosecuted. Marie Jordan served as courtroom clerk.
