Brunswick County will hold a Public Hearing on a proposed 1994 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)—Economic Development Application on June 20, 1994. This application seeks a \$263,092 CDBG grant to be used with \$50,000 in local funds to construct approximately 5,100 LF of gravity sewer line and force main, a lift station, and a 5,100 LF of 8" water main with appurtenances on US 74/76. These improvements will extend existing sewer and water utilities serving the Leland Industrial Park south along US 74/76 to C.T. Specialties Corporation's plant site. This facility is presently served by on-site water (wells) and sewer (lagoon and spray fields) facilities. The proposed water and sewer extensions are necessary for C.T. Specialties Corporation to expand its Brunswick County facility. This expansion will leverage \$375,000 in private expenditures and the creation of 20 new manufacturing jobs within 24 months of which 61% will be filled by qualified individuals having low or moderate incomes.
Total Project Cost: \$688,092; Total CDBG Cost: \$263,092-38%; Total County Funds: \$50,000-7%; C.T. Specialties Cost: \$375,000-55%.
Location of the Project: From the approximate entrance to the Leland Industrial Park on US 74/76, then 4,500 LF south on US 74/76 to C.T. specialties plant site.
