

# Calabash Man Pleads Guilty To Charge Of Allowing Gambling

A Calabash man pleaded guilty last week to a charge of allowing gambling to take place at the Calabash Marina on Riverview Drive.

James Lawrence High Jr., 54, was ordered to pay court costs and to turn over \$345 to the Brunswick County Sheriff's Department Alcohol Law Enforcement Fund after the plea in district court Wednesday. The state voluntarily dismissed charges of gambling, possession of lottery tickets, possession or consumption of a fortified wine, liquor or mixed beverage on an unauthorized premises.

The arrest warrant charged High with "operating a football pool game at which money was bet" and "allowing violations of gambling statutes on an ABC (Alcoholic Beverage Control) licensed premises."

Judge David Wall presided over three days of district court in Bolivia last week. Assistant district attorneys Lee Bollinger, Rick Green and Lillian Salcines prosecuted, while Marie Jordan served as courtroom clerk.
