

Shallotte Man Pleads Guilty To Two Counts Of Property Damage

A 24-year-old Shallotte man was ordered to pay for \$530 worth of damage he caused to the home and personal items of a neighbor last month after pleading guilty in Brunswick County District Court Aug. 9 to charges of injuring property.

The defendant, Michael Boudreau of Suburban Street, was charged with "wantonly damaging four windows, one wall, siding and the underpinning" of a another home in Edgewater Estates on July 9, court records show. Another warrant accused Boudreau of destroying a desk telephone, a window fan, assorted pictures and two sets of blinds belonging to a resident of the home.

Boudreau pleaded guilty to one charge each of injury to real property and injury to personal property. He was sentenced to two years and six months in prison, suspended on the condition that he perform 48 hours of community service and pay restitution, court costs and a \$100 community service fee. He was put on supervised probation and ordered to stay away from the prosecuting witnesses.

Two charges of communicating threats, also filed against Boudreau, were dismissed at the end of the state's evidence.

Judge Napoleon Barefoot Jr. presided over two days of district court in Bolivia last week. Assistant District Attorney Rick Green prosecuted, while Lisa Aycok served as courtroom clerk.

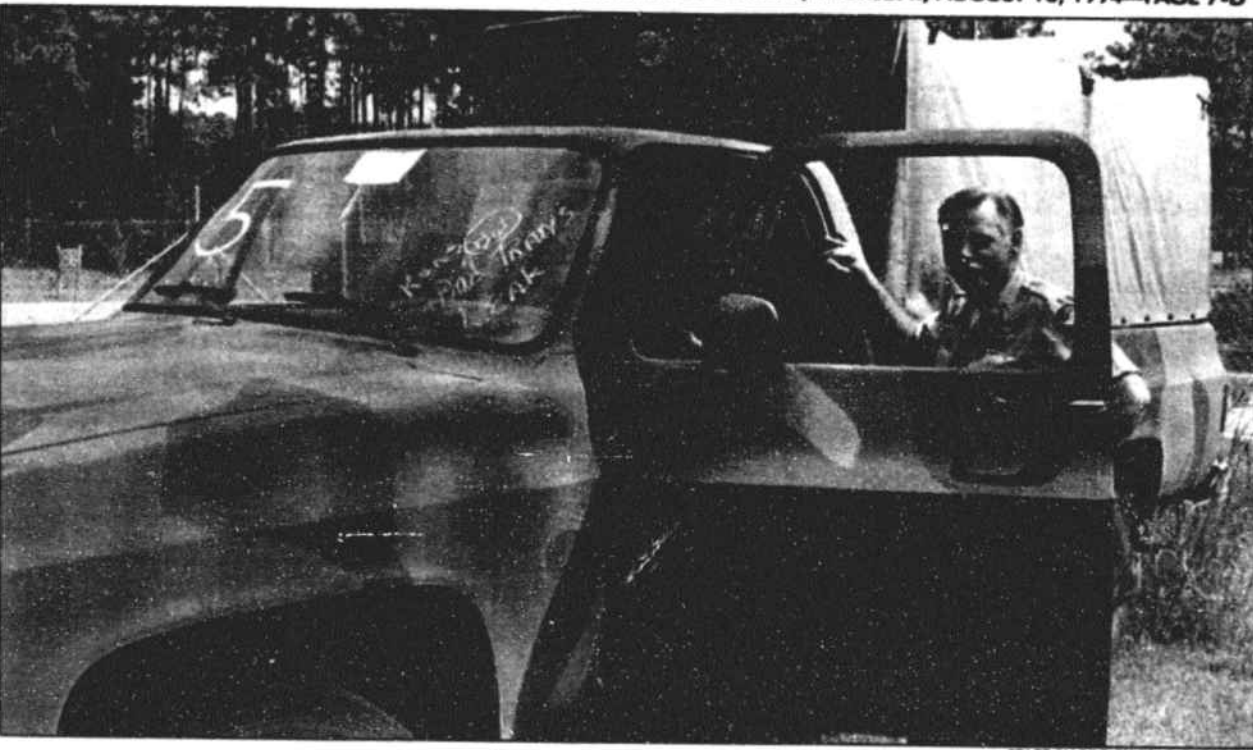

Detective Lt. Carl Pearson of the Brunswick County Sheriff's Department shows one of four 4 X 4 pickup trucks valued at \$63,000 made available through Law Enforcement Support Services (LESS), a new function of the state Department of Crime Control and Public Safety. LESS locates and screens equipment as it becomes available from the U.S. Department of Defense, then notifies requesting agencies of the available goods and coordinates distribution. The program also recently provided the Ocean Isle Beach Police Department two dump trucks with trailers and two four-wheel drive vehicles valued at \$130,899, and the Yaupon Beach Police Department with two 4 X 4 trucks valued at \$31,502. All the equipment is intended to help the departments in drug interdiction efforts.
