

Robert Ruark Foundation Receives Planning Grant

The Robert Ruark Foundation has been awarded a \$750 grant by the N.C. Humanities Council to plan the 1995 Robert Ruark Festival.

The proposed festival, to be held in Southport next summer, will commemorate the literary career of Wilmington native and best-selling writer-journalist Robert C. Ruark, who spent boyhood summers in Southport with his grandparents and used that experience in many of his writings.

The council uses federal funds from the National Endowment for the Humanities and gifts from private sources. It supports programs that draw upon history, literature and languages and meets three times a year to review proposals from non-profit community organizations and institutions.

Bette Leggett, president of the Robert Ruark Foundation and director of the festival, said plans are for activities in the visual, literary and performing arts. They include a screening of the movie, "Something

of Value," made by MGM from Ruark's book of the same name and set in Africa during the anti-colonial period. Panel discussions will be led about the film's literary, sociological and historical perspectives.

Contemporary North Carolina writers will review and discuss selected works set in North Carolina, she added.

"Another possibility we'll be exploring is an arrangement with the

University of North Carolina to include the festival as a summer school offering and perhaps grant teacher recertification credit for participation," she said.

Established in 1989 as a project of the Economic Development Committee, the Robert Ruark Foundation seeks to promote the visual, literary and performing arts through sponsorship of several special events.
