**JTPA Offers Financial Aid To Disadvantaged Students**

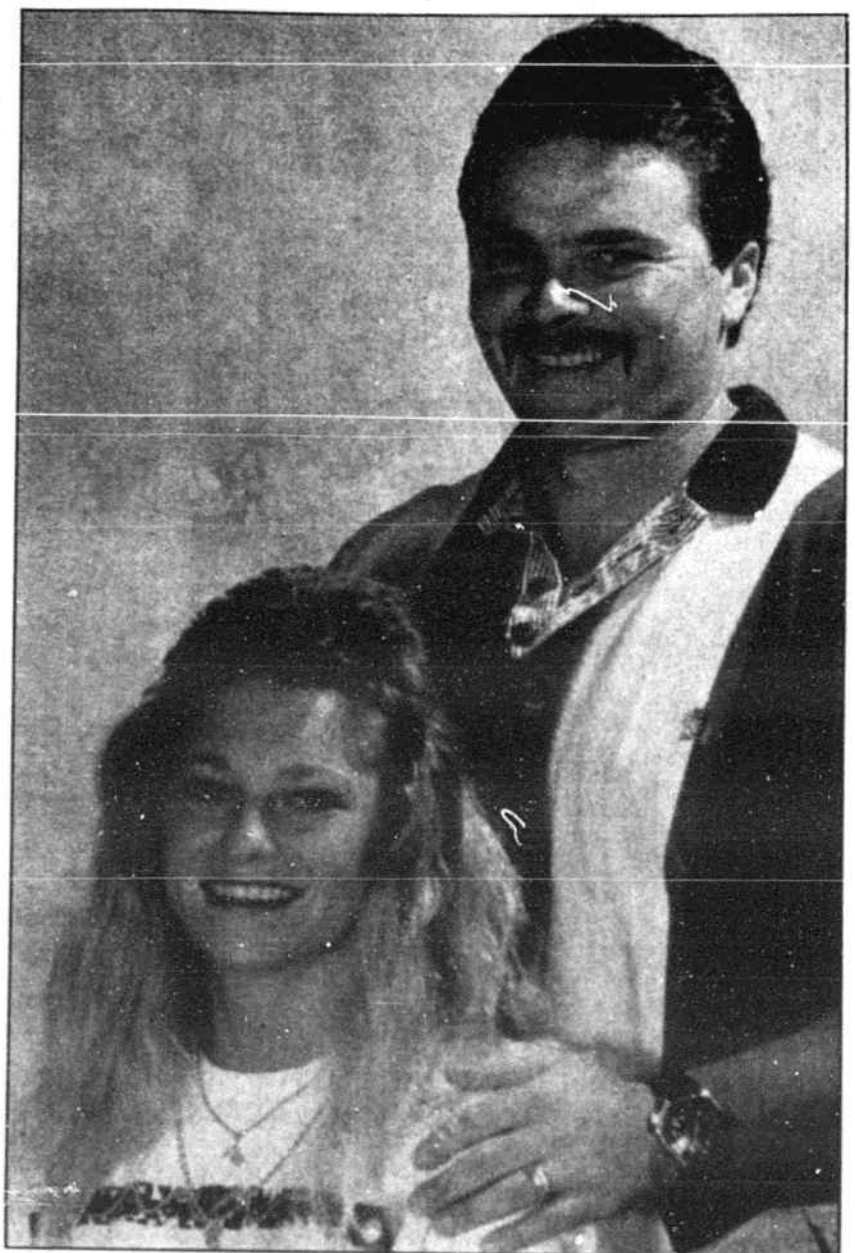
Full scholarships are available through the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) program to eligible students who enroll in selected curriculum programs at Brunswick Community College.
