The Town of Ocean Isle Beach is pleased to announce that it is applying for recertification of its participation in the National Flood Insurance Program Community Rating System. Recertification will allow property owners affected by the Town of Ocean Isle Beach Floodplain Management Ordinance to continue to receive the benefits of a Class 8 Rating.

As a Class 8 community, flood insurance rates are discounted 10 percent on top of any other discounts a property owner may be entitled to through individual actions.

The recertification application procedures require that annual reports be made on several plans and activities. These reports contain information on the Floodplain Management Plan, Flood Warning Program, Repetitive Loss Plan, and other activities required for participation in the Community Rating System. These reports are available for public review in the Office of the Building Inspector.

- To add to the definition section of the zoning ordinance, Chapter 15-12.4, the following:
 - Ground Level**—The average of the highest and lowest elevations on the perimeter of the building footprint established by an official survey provided to the Building Inspector. If a lot is filled after the effective date of this provision, ground level shall not be construed to exceed an elevation more than eighteen (18) inches above the average elevation of the center crown of the designated street address of each specific lot.
 - Average**—The numerical result obtained by dividing the sum of two or more quantities by the number of quantities.
 - Footprint**—The shape of a building reflecting the perimeter of the impervious area of the structure measured from eave to eave.
 - Impervious Area**—Something that is incapable of being passed through or penetrated by water; this shall include, but not be limited to, sidewalks, driveways, patios, swimming pools and any roofed structure from eave to eave.
 - Eave**—An overhanging roof extension.
 - Useable Area**—The available space of a platted lot, after taking into consideration a bulkhead, marsh line, CAMA line, Corps of Engineers line, the first stable line of vegetation, and erosion that may have reduced the available space of the platted lot in size for construction purposes.
 - To create dimensional requirements within the zoning ordinance of the Town within district R (rural), district R1 (residential), district R2 (residential) to provide
 - Building Height**—No building shall exceed a maximum height of thirty-five (35) feet, measured from ground level.
 - Lot Coverage**—The total footprint of the principal structure and all accessory structures shall not exceed thirty (30) percent of the total useable area. For purposes of determining useable area, one seeking a building permit shall furnish the Building Inspector with a survey prepared by a registered land surveyor that must establish the location of any bulkhead, marsh line, CAMA line, Corps of Engineers line and the first stable line of vegetation, if applicable, on each specific lot.
 - To create within District C1 the following:
 - Every building hereafter erected or structurally altered shall not exceed a maximum height of thirty-five (35) feet, measured from ground level.
