week after admitting that he punched his wife in the face, kicked a sheriff's deputy and damaged the officer's patrol car.

Michael Daniels of Seashore Hill Road pleaded guilty in Brunswick County District Court to charges of assault on a female, injury to personal property and assault on a government official.

Daniels was accused of assaulting his wife June 30 by "hitting her in the face with his fist," court records show. He was charged with assaulting Deputy Michael Smith by "kicking him in the left leg" while the officer was attempting to place Daniels under arrest. Another warrant indicates Daniels caused more than \$200 damage to the right rear door of Deputy Randy Robinson's patrol car.

In sentencing Daniels, District Court Judge David Wall combined the three cases for judgment and ordered the defendant to serve two years in prison, "to run at the expiration of any sentence (he is) presently serving.

The judge recommended that Daniels take part in the prison system's Drug Abuse Rehabilitation Training (DART) program.

Judge Wall presided over two days of district court in Bolivia last week. District Attorney Rex Gore and Assistant D.A. Rick Green prosecuted, while Marie Jordan served as courtroom clerk
