North Brunswick Rips Fairmont

Michael Edge rushed for 115 yards and two touchdowns Friday as North Brunswick defeated visiting Fairmont 33-15 in a Three Rivers Conference high school football game.

Edge broke loose for a 75 yard touchdown run on the second play of the game, and added a 10-yard TD run in the fourth quarter to lead the Scorpions to their first conference win in five years.

Quarterback Ryan Brew completed five of eight pass attempts for 155 yards and two touchdowns. Andre Mosley hauled in a 75-yard TD pass, and Shannon Hankins added a 44-yarder.

Lamont Southerland rushed for 64 yards and one touchdown as Coach Garry Bishop's Scorpions posted their second straight win and improved to 3-1 for the season.

The conference win was the first for North Brunswick since Sept. 22, 1989, when the Scorpions defeated West Columbus 14-12 as members of the Waccamaw Conference.

North Brunswick will travel to Elizabethtown Friday night for a tough conference game against the East Bladen Cougars—a team that has owned the Scorpions since the mid-80s.

Excluding 1992, when North Brunswick did not field a varsity football team, the Cougars have beaten the Scorpions every year since 1985.

That's when the two schools became members of the same conference. North Brunswick and East Bladen were members of the Waccamaw Conference from 1985 until 1992, and both moved to the Three Rivers Conference last year.

East Bladen crushed the Scorpions 42-7 last season. In the last eight games the Cougars have outscored North Brunswick 333-38, an average winning margin of 42-5.

North Brunswick's recent meetings with East Bladen include a 59-0 beating in 1990 and 56-0 loss in

West Brunswick High School's volleyball team split a pair of Waccamaw Conference matches last week, beating South Brunswick and losing to South Columbus.

Last Tuesday, junior hitter Michelle Long pounded out 34 service points as the host Lady Trojans knocked off county rival South Brunswick 15-5, 15-5, 15-17, 15-4.

South Columbus got 29 service points from Jamie Bellamy and defeated West Brunswick 11-15, 15-13, 15-10, 12-15, 15-10, last Thursday in Shallotte.

Christy Spivey added 16 points and Penny Jones had 15 for the Lady Gators. Leading West Brunswick were Jessica Winfree with 17 service points, Felicia Morgan with 14 and Madonna Gause with 12.

West Brunswick entered this week 4-3 in the Waccamaw Conference and 8-9 overall. The Lady Trojans had a home match slated Tuesday against unbeaten Pender and are scheduled to play Thursday at Whiteville.
