Shakespeare Comedy To Be Sung At Southeastern Community College

William Shakespeare's *The Merry Wives of Windsor*, set to music by Carl Otto Nicolai, will be sung at the Southeastern Community College auditorium on Sunday, Oct. 9, by the National Opera Company of Raleigh.

Cost of the 3 p.m. performance is \$5 for adults, \$3 for students and senior citizens, or admission by the Southeastern Oratorio Society season ticket.

The comedy is said to have been written at the request of England's Queen Elizabeth I. Nicolai's music was added in 1845.

The elements of the Shakespeare play are all present in the opera—the roistering Sir John Falstaff, the two

agrieved wives, the Garter Inn Tavern and massive oak tree of Herne the Hunter in Windsor Forest. Falstaff, along with dirty laundry, is dumped into the water to escape the wrath of a jealous husband.

The National Opera Company, a touring troupe of 12 singers, was founded in 1948 by the late A.J. Fletcher. Its aims are to introduce opera as an art form to North Carolina school students, to give experience to young artists, and to perform in a language understood by the audience. Since its founding, the company has performed more than 3,000 times in the midwestern, north-eastern and southern states.
