NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sunset Beach Town Council pursuant to G.S. 160A-299 as follows:

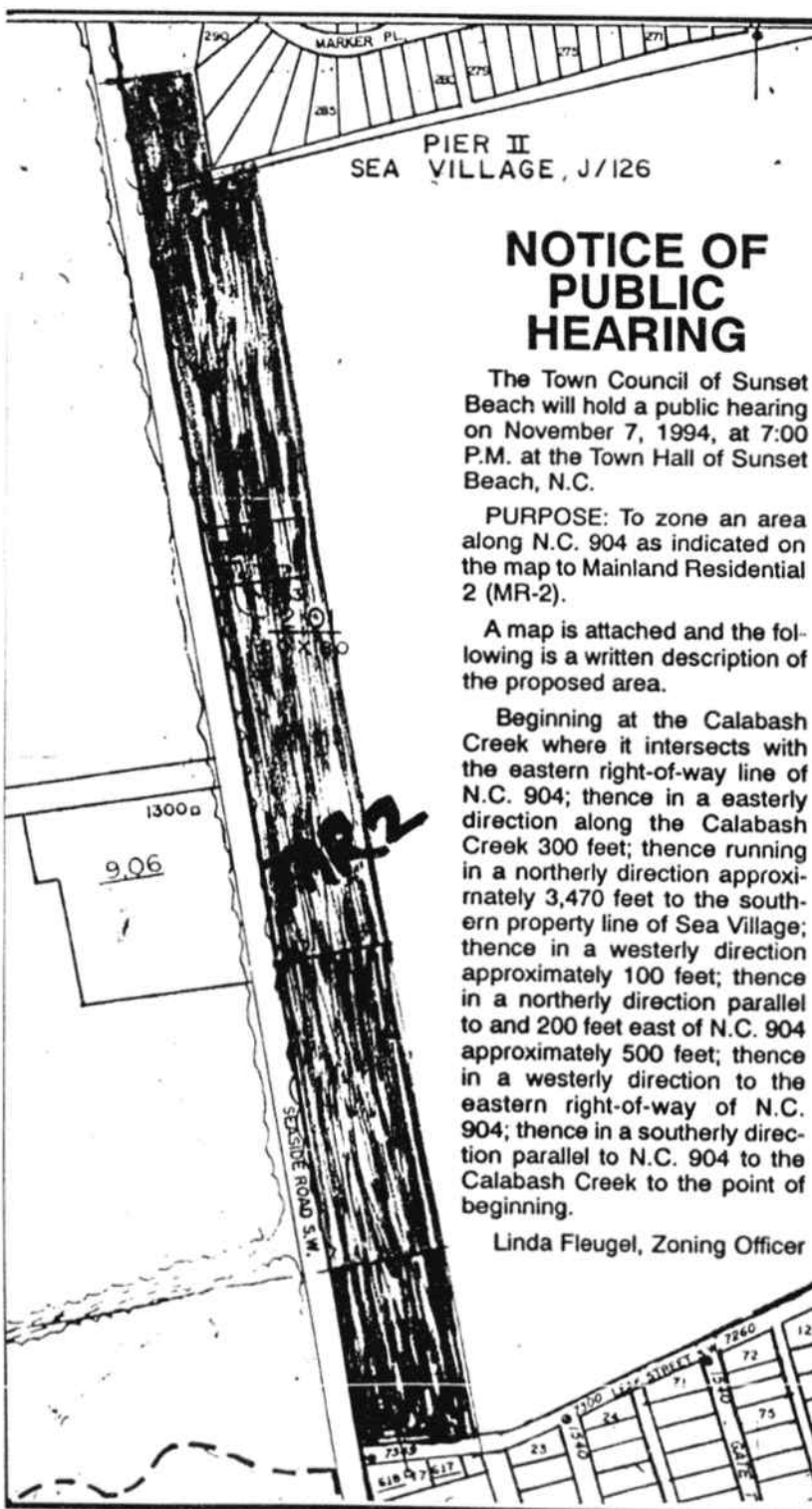

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Town Council of Sunset Beach will hold a public hearing on November 7, 1994, at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall of Sunset Beach, N.C.

PURPOSE: To zone an area along N.C. 904 as indicated on the map to Mainland Residential 2 (MR-2).

A map is attached and the following is a written description of the proposed area.

Beginning at the Calabash Creek where it intersects with the eastern right-of-way line of N.C. 904; thence in a easterly direction along the Calabash Creek 300 feet; thence running in a northerly direction approximately 3,470 feet to the southern property line of Sea Village; thence in a westerly direction approximately 100 feet; thence in a northerly direction parallel to and 200 feet east of N.C. 904 approximately 500 feet; thence in a westerly direction to the eastern right-of-way of N.C. 904; thence in a southerly direction parallel to N.C. 904 to the Calabash Creek to the point of beginning.
