

Timely Questions On Farm Answered

Question: How can I keep my cows from eating dirt and chewing fence rails?

Answer: This is a sure sign that the animals are not getting sufficient minerals in the ration. Check the ration and add the minerals that are deficient.

Question: How can I renew an old, run down pasture?

Answer: Cut down all weeds and shrubbery, and scratch the soil to a depth of about two inches. Use a heavy, spike tooth harrow for this work.

Question: Can I expect heavy egg production from cross bred birds?

Answer: Where well bred stock is used on the first cross the cross-bred birds will do well in the first generation.
